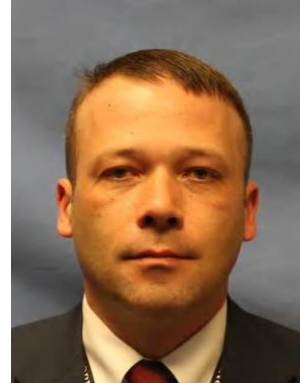

Casey is an Assistant United States Attorney for the United States Department of Justice - United States Attorney's Office for the Southern District of Illinois. In that role, Casey prosecutes a number of criminal offenses on behalf of the United States of America. Currently, his duty assignment includes prosecuting crimes against child and exploitation offenses occurring online and by other means, all part of the National Project Safe Childhood Initiative. Project Safe Childhood (PSC), which was launched in May 2006 by the Department of Justice, is a nationwide initiative to combat the growing epidemic of child sexual exploitation and abuse. PSC marshals federal, state and local resources to better locate, apprehend, and prosecute individuals who exploit children via the Internet, as well as to identify and rescue victims.

In addition, Casey prosecutes a number of other offenses involving drugs, guns and violence, which occur in or otherwise have a connection with the Southern District of Illinois.

Prior to his role with the United States Attorney's Office, Casey served as Associate Judge for the First Judicial Circuit Courts in Illinois. Additionally, Casey served as an Assistant State's Attorney in Jackson County, Illinois for over a decade.
