SOCIAL WORKERS, COUNSELORS, THERAPISTS

Continuing Education Units (CEUs) will be available for conference participants through Northern Illinois University. Attending the entire conference, including conference address, entitles you contact hours. You will need to sign in at each session, including the opening conference address. Also, you will need to complete the form "Application for Continuing Education Units" and submit it with your check for \$9 to Northern Illinois University.

In order for your training credit to be recorded by DCFS, please sign in on the "IDCFS Training Attendance Form" each morning and again each afternoon. The attendance form will be located at the registration desk.

ATTORNEYS

Attorneys can earn CLEs for this conference. In order to receive credit for attending, you will need to sign a separate sign in sheet for each session (in addition to the general sign in sheet for each presentation) and include your ARDC number.
